## 2012 Napa Valley Chardonnay

### Vineyard

Jamieson Canyon, Napa, California. Located in the Southernmost and coolest part of Napa Valley, the slow ripening of the grapes is beneficial for retaining acidity and brightness in the fruit.

### Production

The grapes were hand picked and fermented in Napa Valley, California. After destemming and a gentle press, the juice was settled at cold temperatures for 24 hours and transferred to a stainless steel tank for fermentation. The cool fermentation temperatures allows for accentuation of the fruity aromas. After transportation to our Connecticut winery, the wine was aged in predominantly French oak barrels for 12 months prior to bottling.

### Tasting Notes

Aromas of apple and pear are framed by the toasty vanilla flavors of the oak.
